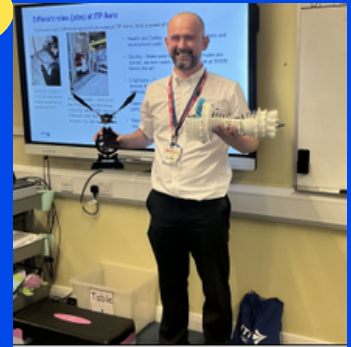

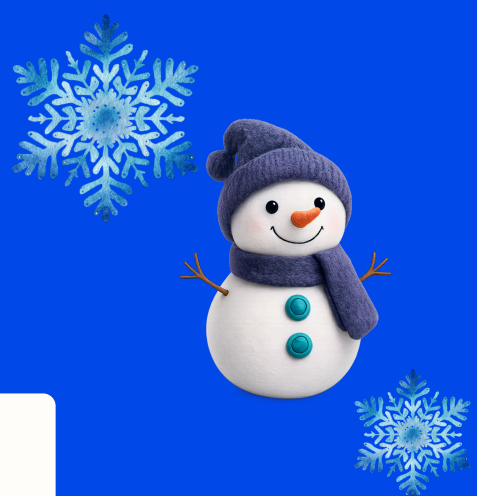
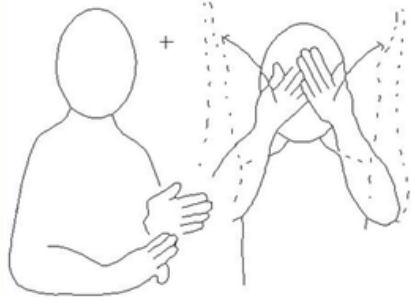
We will be having Aspiration Week next year so please let us know if you feel you can spare some time to join us.
